	Parents – In general we recommend a 3 ring binder for each core subject (Bible, math, science, English, Social Studies/History, and Spanish) as well as dividers, loose leaf notebook paper (college ruled), pens, pencils, highlighters, and a few spiral notebooks for students to start out in the fall. A personal device other than their cell phone is highly recommended.
